

**Student Scholarships:** Exchange Clubs work with high schools to identify Youth of the Year and Accepting the Challenge of Excellence (A.C.E.) scholarship recipients.

**Youth of the Year scholarships** honor outstanding students who have exhibited excellence in academics and leadership. Recipients serve as role models to their peers by exhibiting exceptional scholastic achievement, respect for self and others, community service and ambitious career goals.

**Accepting the Challenge of Excellence (A.C.E.)** award honors students who have overcome often extreme adversity to graduate high school and move their lives in positive directions.

**Students** receiving a local-level scholarship automatically qualify for Exchange District Exchange Clubs scholarships. Winners of the district-level competitions are then eligible to be recognized at the National level, which awards a \$15,000 scholarship to each student.
