They are a rural recovery focused non-profit grounded in community, mental health, and economic resilience bringing hope, purpose and quality of life to unserved rural communities. They are not just focused on addiction, but also trauma, homelessness, and child abuse through culturally relevant systemic care and work with licensed therapists, community health workers and outdoor recreation specialists. They are eventually going to look at getting a building space, rather than remote working.
